Visit Information:

- We ask that participants wear loose-fitting clothing to visits, as they will have sensors attached to their torsos to measure physiological response. Loose-fitting clothing will make properly positioning the sensors much more convenient.
- We encourage participants who wear glasses to wear contact lenses to the visits, as glasses may be mildly uncomfortable to wear during the Virtual Reality task.
- Individuals must be wearing a face mask to be let into the building.
- **If you or someone in your household has symptoms of COVID-19, has tested positive for COVID-19, or has been exposed to someone that tested positive for COVID-19, please do not come in for your appointment. Contact the study coordinator to reschedule your visit.**

Parking & office location at Hopkins

If you will drive to JHU for your visit we ask that you **park in the McElderry Garage** (parking for JHU Outpatient Center visitors) so that we can reimburse you for parking expenses. Please remember to bring your parking ticket with you to the visit. The address of the McElderry Garage is:

601 North Caroline Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21287 (McElderry parking garage)

*Please note: There are two separate entrances to the McElderry Garage. Please be sure to enter from McElderry St., not Jefferson St. When you make the turn onto McElderry street, there should be a garage on your right and left, with a circle ahead of you. The McElderry Garage is on your right.

Your study visit will take place in **Room 206** of the **550 Building** on the Johns Hopkins Hospital Campus. The address to the 550 Building is:

550 N Broadway, Suite 206, Baltimore, MD 21205 (office location)

Note: We have also included driving directions to the McElderry Garage at the end of this document.

Directions from the parking garage to our building

***Important Reminders:**

-We recommend that participants bring a digital or printed version of these instructions to help find our offices.

-Please follow these exact directions. If you stop and ask for directions you may be directed to the wrong office because there are multiple divisions of Child Psychiatry dispersed throughout the campus.

-Please call us at any time (443-300-8836) if you are having trouble locating us.

DIRECTIONS BEGIN HERE:

- From the McElderry Garage, there is a path that leads to the Outpatient Center building.
- Rather than walking through the Outpatient building, we ask that you **walk around the left side of the Outpatient building**.
- You will see a red brick walkway leading up to the Johns Hopkins Dome (see picture below)

- **Continue up the red brick walkway** until you get to the back-end of the Outpatient Center (NOTE: if you have reached Broadway then you have gone too far). You will then **turn right when you see a “smoke free campus” sign and 4 large concrete columns** (see picture below).



- Proceed past the smoke-free sign and columns toward the brick building in the distance (the brick building is the 550 Building-you're almost there!)
- As you walk past the columns you will see a **black, outdoor ramp that leads down to the 550 Building** (see picture below). You will also see a sign on the building across the ramp that says, "550 N Broadway."



- Once you have crossed over the ramp, the entrance of the 550 Building is located just around the left side of the building.
- Due to COVID-19 precautions, you will not be permitted to enter the building. Call us when you arrive (443-300-8836) and we will come down to meet you. When we arrive downstairs to meet you, we will ask COVID screening questions, verify that you have a mask, and check your temperature. We will then let you into the building.

Driving directions to the McElderry parking garage

From Washington, D.C., and Virginia and the I-95 access at Baltimore-Washington International Airport:

- Take I-95 north to Exit 53 (I-395 north) into Baltimore. (Note: Do not take the Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. fork of the exit.)
- Turn right at Pratt Street (by Baltimore Convention Center). □ Stay on Pratt Street for 1.4 miles to Caroline; turn left on Caroline St □ Make right onto McElderry St to enter parking garage.

From Philadelphia, New York and Northeastern

Baltimore Suburbs □ Take I-95 south to I-895 south split. Stay on I-895 south.

- Take the Moravia Rd (To Rte. 40) exit. □ At traffic light, make left. Stay in Right lane □ Take Rt. 40 exit on right-hand side.
- Stay on Rt. 40, which will turn into Orleans St.
- Follow Orleans St. to Caroline St.; Turn right on Caroline.
- Make right onto McElderry St to enter parking garage.

From Annapolis and Maryland's Eastern Shore

- From Route 50, take I-97 toward Baltimore.
- Follow I-97 to the Baltimore Beltway (I-695) toward Towson.
- Take the Beltway to the Baltimore-Washington Parkway (I-295) North.
- Follow I-295 into Baltimore (it becomes Russell Street).
- Turn right at Pratt Street.
- Stay on Pratt for 1.4 miles to Caroline; turn left on Caroline
- Make right onto McElderry St. to enter parking garage

From Frederick and Western Maryland

- Take I-70 East to the Baltimore Beltway (I-695) East to I-95 North.
- Take I-95 North to Exit 53 (I-395 north) into Baltimore.
- Turn right at Pratt Street (by Baltimore Convention Center).

- Stay on Pratt for 1.4 miles; turn left on Caroline
- Make right onto McElderry St. to enter parking garage

From York, Central Pennsylvania and Northern Baltimore Suburbs

- Take I-83 South (Harrisburg Expressway) into Baltimore (Note: I-83 becomes the Jones Falls Expressway as you approach Baltimore).
- Exit at Fayette Street and turn left.
- Follow Fayette toward the medical campus. Make left onto Caroline St.
- Follow Caroline St. to McElderry St. Make right onto McElderry St. to enter parking garage.
